Further information on Inspiring Impact

The whole programme is aimed at charities who want to start to understand and improve their impact, the programme offers:

- Flexible grants that charities & social enterprises can spend on understanding and improving their impact. The existing programmes have previously awarded nearly £2m of grants across the UK.
- A website that brings together the best free resources from across the sector, including the Data Diagnostic, a 5-minute questionnaire that provides tailored recommendations about what data to collect. Over 100,000 people have used the website already.
- Networks that bring people together to share what works and learn from each other. The voluntary sector looks different in England, Scotland, Northern Ireland and Wales so local partners will adapt their activities to local demand.

As the delivery partner for Inspiring Impact in England, Social Value UK aim to support the development of impact management practice within Civil Society organisations throughout England, to do this Social Value UK will be delivering a series of events and support. These events aim to:

- Build on the knowledge and support that has already been developed in the Inspiring Impact and the Impact Management Programmes previously
- Facilitate peer networks for Civil Society organisations that also integrate with a wider cross-sectoral network.
- Developing the knowledge, skills and experience of Civil Society Organisations
